Our Glamping/Camping Hotel in Mussoorie is conveniently located near Mussoorie Mall Road, specifically at Library Chowk, a mere 3 km away. It's just a 5-minute drive by car or bike. Nestled in a picturesque setting, our luxury camping site offers breathtaking views of Gangotri & Kedarnath, surrounded by lush green forests. You can easily find the exact location and directions on our website map and Google Maps. For further assistance, we'll be happy to provide directions upon booking. Alternatively, you can take the 'Hathi Paon route' midway on the normal route to reach us directly, avoiding the entire Mall Road.

3. Accommodation Options and Safety:

- A. . **Premium Tents (located near the forest end):** These tents offer heating facilities, including blowers, electric blankets, a mini-fridge, fan, and a safe. (Two Swiss tents available).
- B. **Deluxe Tents (located in the middle):** Equipped with electrical blankets for added comfort. (Two Swiss tents available). (Additional Rs. 1000/chargeable per night for blowers)
- C. **Himalayan View Luxe Swiss Tent (located near the entrance):** Provides stunning views of the Himalayas, with heating equipment available at an additional cost. (One Swiss tent available). (Additional Rs. 1000/- chargeable per night for blowers and Rs. 700/- per night for electrical blankets).



Our Swiss Glamping tents are weatherproof and have withstood storms and snow. While they may make noise when it rains, rest assured they are absolutely safe.

If one wants to experience snow one must visit Mussoorie between December to February.
